

Geomove: Privacy Policy

Any user under the age of 13 must review this Privacy Policy with a parent or legal guardian ("referring adult") who must also validate his or her registration.

Any referring adult accepts this Privacy Policy on their own behalf and that of the child. Accept on their behalf and that of the child.

1. Subject

This Privacy Policy is applicable to the processing of data carried out by the NGO Geomoun, whose registered office is located at 1325 Corroy-le-Grand, Chemin de la Dîme 43, registered with the Crossroads Bank for Enterprises under number 0472.089.102 (hereinafter "Geomoun" or "NGO Geomoun").

The purpose of this Privacy Policy is to specify the categories of personal data that Geomoun collects in the exercise of its activities related to Geomove and on its website (www.geomove.net), on its sub-domains and/or via directories, applications, services and any other means related to information and communication technologies, including emails (hereinafter "Website" or "Geomove"). It also describes how the data may be processed and disclosed to third parties. The Privacy Policy also defines the various measures that Geomoun has implemented in order to safeguard the security and confidentiality of the personal data collected.

Geomoun is concerned about the privacy of Geomove Users and those whose personal data may be collected (hereinafter "User" or "you" or "your"). It only collects and processes personal data in accordance with the provisions of this Privacy Policy and the legislation in force.

Geomoun shall be considered as responsible for the processing of personal data and shall act in accordance with :

- The European provisions of the Regulation on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (hereinafter referred to as the "European General Data Protection Regulation" or "GDPR") of 27 April 2016, which came into force in Belgium on 25 May 2018;
- The provisions of the Belgian law on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data of 30 July 2018 (hereinafter the "Privacy Law");
- The provisions of the Belgian Electronic Communications Act of 13 June 2005 and its amendments;
- The provisions specified in this Privacy Policy.

2. Consent - Third Party Website

If you use this Website as a User, if you decide to register, register or disclose information on this Website, you agree to the processing of your data in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

Geomoun reserves the right to modify this Privacy Policy at any time and without prior notice, in order to comply with (new) legal obligations and/or to improve its services. We therefore advise each user to regularly consult the Website.

It should be borne in mind that this Website may contain links to other digital platforms or Internet resources that may also collect personal data voluntarily, by means of cookies or other technologies. Geomoun declines all responsibility for these sites and Internet resources for which it is not responsible and for which it does not control the collection, use and disclosure of your personal data by these third parties. Geomoun recommends that you review the Privacy Policies of these other sites and Internet resources in order to understand how they collect and use your personal data.

3. Personal data collected by Geomove

The categories of personal data that may be collected are: those relating to a User's computer and the use of the Website, such as IP addresses, geographical location, browser type and version, operating system, duration and date of visit, pages viewed and navigation on the site, etc. provided by the User when visiting the Website, using the services provided by Geomoun or communicating with Geomoun. This includes data such as: name, e-mail address, telephone number, country, profile...

The use of cookies and Internet tags by Geomoun is specified in the Cookie Policy available on the Website.

Users may not disclose personal data relating to another person to Geomoun, unless that person has consented to such disclosure in accordance with this Privacy Policy and the legal provisions in force.

Geomoun does not collect sensitive data. This includes data such as that related to a User's race or ethnic origin, religious beliefs, sexual orientation or physical health. Geomoun will, if necessary, ask for your explicit consent to collect such data.

4. Use of personal data

Geomoun acts as the controller of personal data and will process this data for the following purposes: user administration, advertising, market research, improving the functionality of Geomove's services, providing third parties with statistical information about Users, carrying out direct marketing including sending newsletters, improving the content and quality of the Website and services, improving the compatibility of the Website and services with the interests, needs and desires of Users, as well as to enable the accurate monitoring, improvement and completion of personal data in accordance with the law.

Geomoun ensures that its marketing activities comply with applicable legislation and that it obtains Users' authorisation to send e-mails or other electronic communications from

Geomoun or one of its partners. Users may at any time request the interruption of communications relating to information of this nature.

5. The rights of the User

Each User has the right to access, modify, rectify and delete his or her data. He or she may also object, free of charge and on simple request, to the processing of his or her data for direct marketing purposes. This data may, except in the event of opposition, be transmitted to third parties within the limits and under the conditions set out in section 6 of this Privacy Policy. The aforementioned right may be exercised by writing to Geomoun at the following address geomove@geomoun.org accompanied by a copy of the front of your identity card.

Geomoun takes all reasonable steps to ensure the confidentiality of the personal data transmitted by a User. However, each User acknowledges that the communication of personal data via the Internet is not exempt from all risks. The User therefore acknowledges that Geomoun cannot be held liable for any direct or indirect damage suffered by the User as a result of illegal or irregular use of his/her personal data by third parties not authorised to use such data.

6. Transmission of personal data

Although Geomoun is authorised to transfer data to service providers who use data on its behalf, Geomoun will not communicate any data to third parties for secondary or distinct purposes other than those mentioned above, unless otherwise stated at the time of collection of such judicial data, to administrative authorities or other bodies, or to third parties if this proves necessary or desirable to meet legal or regulatory obligations or for the purposes mentioned above.

7. Duration of data retention

Geomoun does not keep the data collected beyond the period provided for by law and, in any case, not for a longer period than necessary for the purposes mentioned below.

8. International transfer of data

Geomoun does not transfer personal data to countries that do not have data protection legislation equivalent to that in force in the European Economic Area.

Personal data may be stored and processed within the European Economic Area only insofar as this is necessary in order to carry out the processing or in a manner compatible with the purposes of the processing.

9. Data protection

Geomoun uses reasonable and commonly accepted technological standards, as well as operational security standards to protect against the loss, abuse, modification or destruction of any information communicated by Users.

The User acknowledges that the transmission of data over the Internet is inherently risky, and that we cannot guarantee the security of data sent over the Internet.

10. Registration with the supervisory authority

Geomoun has registered its activity as a data controller with the Belgian Commission for the Protection of Privacy.

11. Amendments to the Privacy Policy

Geomoun may modify its Confidentiality policy specific to the use of Geomove at any time by publishing a new version of it on the Website. We recommend that you check the Privacy Policy regularly as you are bound by these changes.
